

EMERGENCY PHONE

Allows elevator passengers to call for help

Emergency phones are installed in elevators so trapped or distressed passengers can call for help.

Hands-free emergency phones are required by code in elevator cabs. They're especially useful if the passengers are unable to pick up a receiver. When a call for help is initiated, the phone immediately dials preprogrammed phone numbers until a live person is reached.

Once the call is acknowledged, a blinking LED light indicates that the call was answered and help is on the way.
